



Possibilities for Change

Professional Development Workshop Evaluation

Increasing Staff-Student Interaction in Challenging Environments is a 4.5 hour professional development workshop and key component of A Program to Improve Graduation by Integrating Public Health Prevention and Primary Care in Schools. Participants examine approaches to increase effective communications with adolescents, synthesize and practice techniques introduced in online modules, and consider strategies that enhance school climate. Topics covered include: (1) assumptions and comfort levels; (2) approaching adolescents and giving information; (3) motivational interviewing communication strategies; and (4) working with adolescents in challenging situations.
